BIOGRAPHY:

George and Archibald Wither originated from Scotland. George came to Steamboat Springs in 1889, with George joining in 1898. The brothers operated a successful mercantile business in Hahns Peak before moving it to Steamboat Springs in 1902. Archie married Pearl Carleton of Snake River in 1899 and they had their first child, George in 1900. The Wither Brothers Store in Steamboat Springs was the largest in the region at 25,000 square feet, with a 25' x60' warehouse in the back. Archie and Pearl's children George, Eva Dorothy, Donald (Pete) and Robert (Bob) grew up in Steamboat Springs and served as valued community members.

The Dorothy Shop, owned and operated by Dorothy Wither, opened on Lincoln Ave. in 1939 and was an iconic business for the next 50 years. The shop sold women's clothing. In 1967 Dorothy Wither received Woman of the Year. Wither was intricately involved with the community at large and founded the Tread of Pioneers Museum in 1959.
